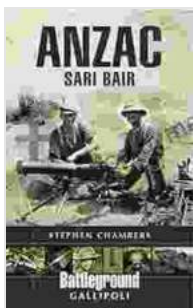

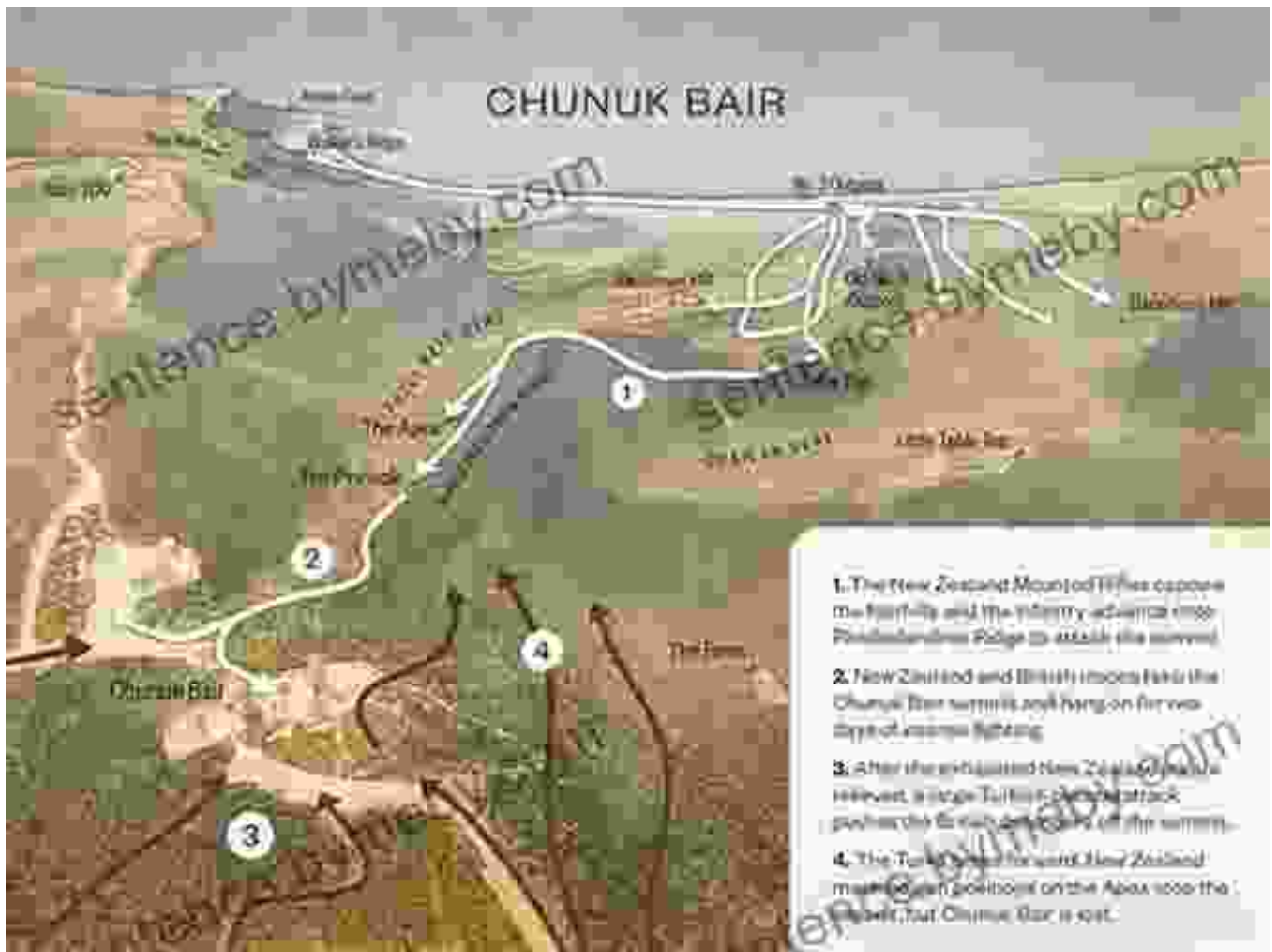
Stunning Photography

The Nek, a narrow ridge that the ANZACs attempted to capture on August 7, 1915.

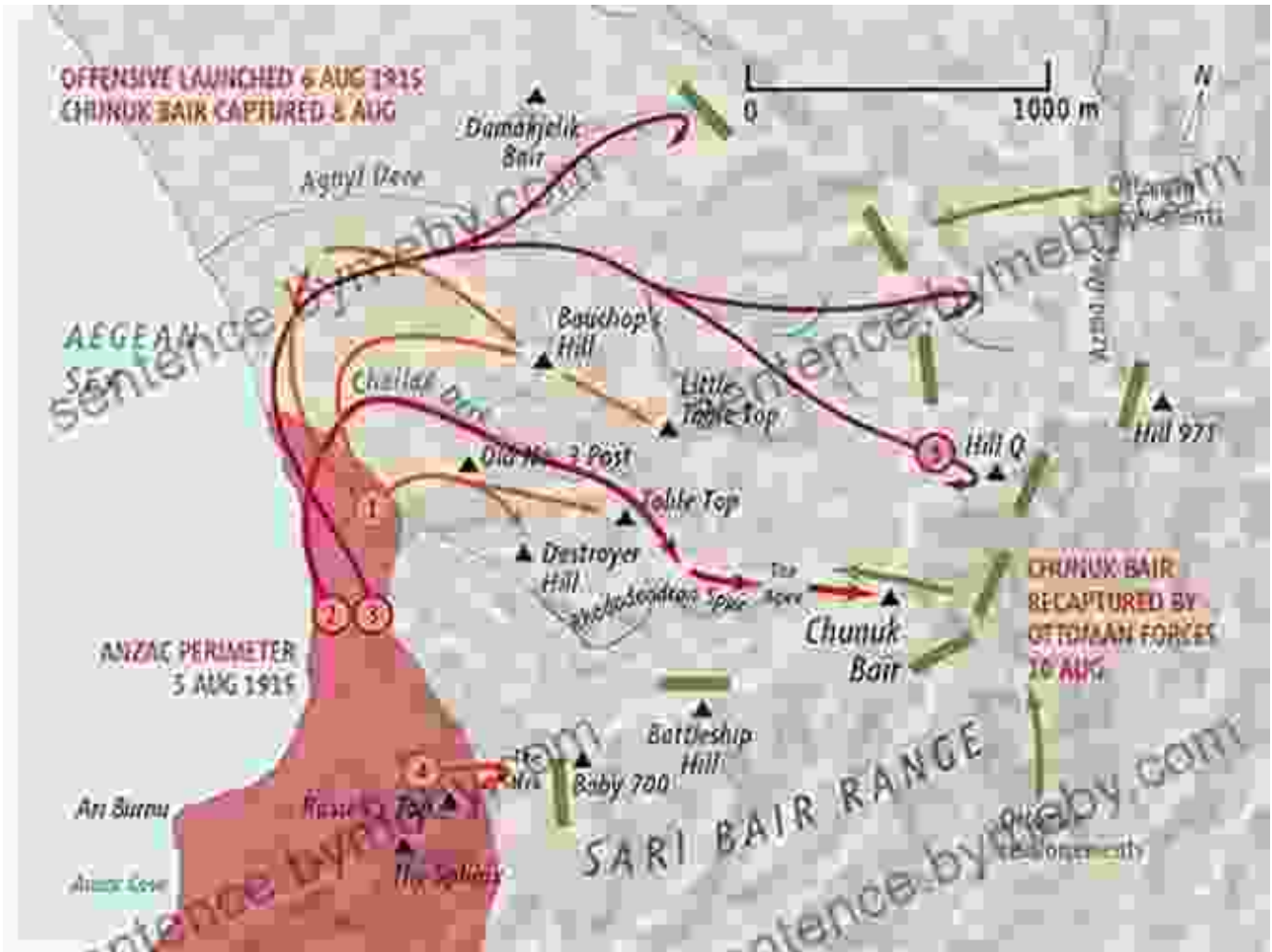


Detailed Maps

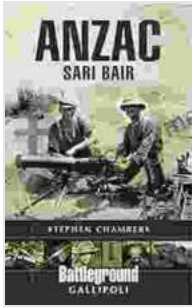

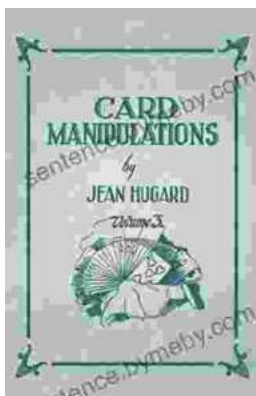
