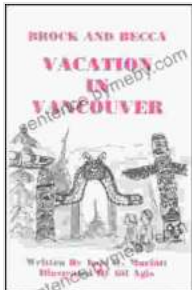


# Brock and Becca's Unforgettable Vacation in Vancouver
