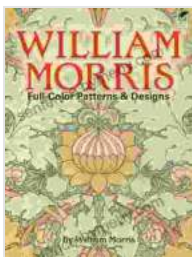

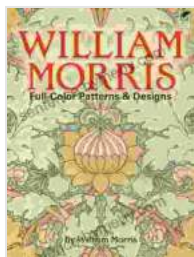


## About William Morris
